As a stand-up comedian, Gaffigan's clever, quiet style is captured to perfection on his third album, "King Baby." His first CD, "Doing My Time," has sold over 75,000 copies and his second, "Beyond The Pale," has sold in excess of 175,000.

The greatly anticipated follow-up to the platinum-selling "Beyond the Pale" DVD, the "King Baby" DVD boasts over 30 minutes of stand-up never-before-seen in the aired COMEDY CENTRAL special. Scripted television guest appearances include an upcoming guest starring role on HBO's cult hit "Flight of the Conchords," with previous roles on "That 70's Show," "Ed," "Sex and the City," "The Ellen Show," "Third Watch" and all three of the "Law & Order" show variations. Gaffigan has also been seen in such films as "The Love Guru," "13 Going On 30," "Super Troopers," "17," "Three Kings," the independent film "The Living Wake," and "The Great New Wonderful," a meditation on the aftermath of 9/11.
