NEW YORK, Feb. 18 -- Web phenomenon and soon-to-be film, television and radio sensation Bo Burnham brings his first full-length CD/DVD to COMEDY CENTRAL Records to be released on March 10. Burnham has been tapped by Judd Apatow to write and potentially star in an upcoming film for Universal Pictures and when he isn't on set, Burnham will be touring the country, selling out shows from coast to coast. His first digital-only EP "Bo Fo Sho" on COMEDY CENTRAL Records sold over 20,000 copies in the first three months and continues to go strong.
