

Paul McCartney to Appear on 'The Colbert Report' on Wednesday, January 28 at 11:30 P.M. ET/PT

Stewart, Colbert and Allison Silverman are the executive producers with Meredith Bennett and Richard Dahm as co-executive producers. Jim Hoskinson is the director.
